Oxyethcin is a preventative antibiotic that is specifically formulated to halt the growth of small infections in their early stages. The drug is particularly effective against most types of bacterial illnesses.

History

The inception of Oxyethcin was driven by Advancer Enterprises' ambition to create a first-line defense against bacterial infections. Recognizing the limitations of existing antibiotics, particularly their broad-spectrum nature that often led to resistance, Advancer focused on a targeted approach. The drug was developed over a span of two years, involving rigorous clinical trials. The result was a finely-tuned antibiotic that could nip infections in the bud without causing undue harm to the body's microbiome.

Usage

Oxyethcin operates by inhibiting bacterial protein synthesis, effectively halting their growth and reproduction. This allows the body's immune system to eliminate the remaining bacteria, preventing minor infections from escalating into severe conditions. The drug comes in 100mg tablets and is administered orally. For adults, the standard dosage is one tablet every 12 hours for a duration of 5 to 7 days, depending on the severity of the infection.

Side Effects

Overdose
