About

Geshrinari Shipyards produces both military and civilian craft, including craft for the [Star Army of Yamatai](#). Geshrinari is also notable for its special relationship with [Ketsurui Fleet Yards](#), which has allowed it to make use of advanced technologies such as [Combined Field Systems](#).

History

Geshrinari Shipyards was a [Nepleslian](#) shipbuilding corporation, and it predates the [Yamatai Star Empire](#). It was previously one of the largest companies of Nepleslia, and was once closely affiliated with the [Nepleslian Reds](#). Some considered the early Geshrinari Shipyards of these years to be 'mob-connected' due to their closeness with the Reds and the [Black Syndicate](#). by [YE 28](#), Geshrinari was no longer headquartered on Nepleslia. In modern history, the *Geshrinari Shipyards* have been headquartered in the [Yamatai Star Empire](#). Over the years, it has enjoyed doing business with the governments of Yamatai and the [Democratic Imperium of Nepleslia](#).

In [YE 33](#) the company was acquired by the [Tamahagane Corporation](#), and is now the shipbuilding division for that company.

In [YE 42](#), the company began manufacturing ships in the [Rapid Disaster Response Service](#) line. These vessels were designed to assist in disaster recovery and emergency situations.
