

Takavonai (Language)

Takavonai or “*speech of the people*” is the language of the [Poku Saeruo Degonjo](#). It is pronounced as tă-kă-vōnăě. The language dates back to the time before the [Norka \(The Exodus\)](#). The language of the Clan also includes [Physical Displays](#).



Language Forms

There are three forms of the language used by the [Poku'vonai](#). But communications is not just about the words, but gestures and mannerisms can alter the meaning of some phrases.

Gestures

These are some of the more common gestures or mannerisms used in conversation.

- baring of teeth - sincerity
- flaring of nostrils - disapproval
- holding an open hand up - peaceful
- holding a clenched hand up - aggression
- tail moving excessively - excitement
- tail still against back - threatened
- tail wrapped around waist - guarded

Common Tongue

This is the colloquial way of speaking, for all normal day to day communications.

Formal Tongue

Formal Tongue is a more archaic form of their language. It would be the difference between modern English, and Old English. It is only used during rituals.

Battle Tongue

Is a shortened way of phrasing things for concise battle commands. It is not for normal conversation use. Example:

Ten-hut is an American military term that means, “Come to attention!”  [Wikipedia](#)

Antonyms

- sumanâ - create, make
- ânamus - destroy, break
- uos - life
- sou - death

Dictionary

The [Poku'vonai](#) language uses  [Phonogram](#), however for simplification English letters are used rather than creating a unique series for use on the web. There are 24  [Phonemes](#) in the language. See pronunciation table for proper sounds. The following letters are not used: c, x, z.
